SBAC vs NH-SAS

We have only just become used to the terminology and layout of the SBAC results and now we have to learn to ‘read’ the SAS results. For the SBAC we had SUBJECTS, CLAIMS, TARGETS and STANDARDS. Now we have SUBJECTS, CATEGORIES, CLUSTERS and STANDARDS as shown below:

<u>SBAC</u>		<u>SAS</u>
Subject	>>>	Subject
Claim	>>>	Category
Target	>>>	Cluster
Standard	>>>	Standard

At the highest level, it is safe to compare the overall scores of the two tests. As analysis gets more granular, results from one test to the other are not comparable. If, for example, a teacher team had a year-long goal related to **Improving Research for ELA**, there will not be a comparable score in the SAS this year. But, if the team had a goal of improving
